The MBCI library subscribes to a number of password-protected academic resources, including journal databases, non-fiction eBook collections, and online Encyclopedias for both middle and high school students. During this time if you are looking for an academic alternative to Google in order to assist your child, please consider these resources. All of these can be found on your child's Edsby page, as part of the Library Resources group.

Passwords to each of the databases can be found on Edsby> Library Resources. A link to the passwords can be found pinned on the left side of the page.

<u>Worldbook Online</u>: A general online encyclopedia; great for finding out information about people, places, ideas, events, and major ideas.

<u>Infobase:</u> Our eBook collection of approximately 6,000 non-fiction eBooks. Ebooks on this database can be found using a simple keyword search.

<u>Literature Resource Centre</u>: A great collection of literary information, including biographies of notable authors, poets, etc., as well as journal articles, encyclopedia articles, and much more about notable published works.

<u>Science in Context</u>: A collection of journal, encyclopedia, newspaper, video and academic articles related to chemistry, biology, physics, and geology, as well as much more.

<u>A-Z World Culture</u>: A collection of up to date information about every country of the world, including demographics, cultural customs, maps, government, religious practices, etc.

<u>GreenR</u>: An environmental database with different climate and environment related information (journals, encyclopedias, newspapers, videos, etc.)

<u>Non-Fiction books:</u> a variety of print, non-fiction library books are also available. Please look on the MBCI library catalogue (available on the "passwords" page on Edsby Library Resources) for books, and email Jennifer Wohlgemut with book requests at: jwohlgemut@mbci.mb.ca.
