FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) What is the event about?

The Benefit Dinner is an annual event where our community of parents, grandparents, alumni, staff and board come together to celebrate MBCI and raise funds that help change the lives of our students.

The evening begins at 6pm with a Welcome Reception where you can mingle with other guests and enjoy interacting with students and hear and see about their learning experiences. Dinner begins at 7pm with the program to follow. Throughout the evening there are various prize events; including silent auction and raffles. While enjoying a fantastic three course dinner, you will be entertained by students, staff and others from our MBCI community. The program typically wraps up around 9:30pm, after which guests are welcome to stay and mingle.

2) How much are tickets?

Tickets are not sold to this event. All members of the school community are welcome to attend and will be asked to make a gift at the dinner.

3) How are funds from this year's dinner being used?

We are excited to announce the revitalization of Jubilee Place which will include new seating, flooring, railing, paint and enhanced handicap accessibility. Jubilee Place has been home to many musicals and for over 30 years been the centre of performance, learning, worship and celebration of our student community . All donations received at the dinner will go towards the \$325,000 campaign.

4) Will I receive a charitable tax receipt for my donation?

A partial tax receipt will be issued. According to Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) Guidelines, the value of the advantage (in this case the cost of the dinner) must be deducted from your donation.

5) Where do I park?

The RBC Convention Centre has an underground parkade and street parking is also available.

6) What's the dress code?

The evening is considered semi-formal or dressy casual.
