**Code of Conduct**

Our school is a place that promotes respect and responsibility in a safe learning and teaching environment. We attempt to embody in our community the values expressed in the Christian Bible, as interpreted in the Confession of Faith of the Canadian Conference of Mennonite Brethren Churches. All members of the MBCI community, including staff, students, parents, board members, and volunteers have the right to experience positive school life, whether on school property or at school-authorized events. With this right comes the responsibility to uphold the shared values of the community.

All school members must demonstrate the following behaviour:

- Show self-respect in appearance and conduct;
- Demonstrate personal honesty and academic integrity;
- Treat all people with fairness and respect;
- Speak well of others, not using abusive language or aggressive behaviour;
- Resolve conflicts peacefully;
- Show respect for the property of the school and of others;
- Show respect for the school and the values of the community;
- Respect and comply with all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws;

The behaviour listed below is specifically not acceptable:

- Dressing inappropriately, as defined in the Student Handbook;
- Injuring or harming yourself;
- Lying, deception, or cheating;
- Reading or viewing pornographic material;
- Sexually assaulting or harassing another person;
- Threatening or intimidating another person;
- Causing injury to another person;
- Possessing weapons;
- Possessing drugs or alcohol;
- Using profane or blasphemous language;
- Using racial slurs or expressing racist ideas;
- Damaging or stealing school property or the property of others;
- Violating any applicable federal, provincial or municipal laws.
