

# Information on the MBA Junior Band Summer Camp at MBCI!

Hello, MBCI Grade 6-9 Band Students and Parent/Guardians!

Please kindly take a minute to review the following information.

We want to make each of you aware of an important enrichment opportunity available to all band students. Each August, the MBA runs a week-long junior band summer day camp, located at four schools - Mennonite Brethren Collegiate Institute, Vincent Massey Collegiate, Hedges Middle School, and Springfield Middle School. These camps are geared toward students with 1-3 years of experience on their band instrument (although we always have a number of Grade 9 students who may have played for 4 years). This past summer, MBCI's camp was once again a huge success with 75 students coming from 22 different schools, and taught by 23 instructors. 18 students were from MBCI. Over the past 20 years, many MBCI students have greatly benefitted from these camps, and had a lot of fun meeting new friends with similar interests and values. It is very important that if you are interested that you register early - MBCI's camp location often fills up by the end of April, six weeks before the early registration deadline of June 15. As a result, a number of students who try registering at the last minute often do not get in.

The conductor for the camp is Mr. H. Andrew Wahl, who always brings his unique brand of inspired musicianship and warm humour to the camp. Camp activities include full band rehearsals, chamber ensemble rehearsals, sectional rehearsals and instrumental technique, Intro to Jazz Level I and II, Percussion Techniques, and outdoor recreation. First time students to the camp get valuable enrichment topics such as *Developing Good Practice Habits* and *How to Prepare an Honour Band Audition*. Returning students are given opportunity to learn the basics of composing, conducting, and other advanced topics.

Over 1000 young musicians have attended the MBCI camp over the past 20 years, with many returning for a second, third, or fourth year. Camps have a positive influence on student's participation in other musical endeavors - honour bands, solo and ensemble festivals, and always enrich the school programs to which they return. Over the years at MBCI, we have enjoyed the benefits of many of our students going to various camps, with respect to their musical development, and what they have given back to MBCI the next year and beyond. We want to heartily encourage each student to give Junior Band Summer Camps serious consideration.
