# MBCI Music Awards 2024

Each year six students from Grade 9 and six students from Grade 12 are selected to receive MBCI Music Awards. Students qualify by being nominated by their peers using a set of eight criteria. Nominees need to show strong evidence of several of the following qualities:

- Uses musical gifts to glorify God, and encourage others to do so
- Shows exemplary participation in classes involving music at MBCI
- Demonstrates superior musicianship
- Shows positive leadership and citizenship at MBCI
- Shows a willingness to work together with and help others in the area of music
- Participates in co-curricular music ensembles
- Is involved in music ministry at church
- Participates in music activities outside MBCI
