Notes for all Middle School Families:

- Please take note of the schedule specifically for your child's grade since dates are different for various grades in middle school.
- Please take note of the dates for the "end of regular classes". Any dates listed following the last day of classes are special event days and may have timing that is different from the regular class schedule.
- If you have a student in Grade 7/8, please check the evaluation schedule carefully for the days that your child needs to be at school.
- Middle School Awards Assembly: The assembly begins at 9:00 am, lasts for about an hour, after which all students are dismissed. The assembly includes presentation of Honours and First Class Honours certificates as well as Middle School awards. All parents/guardians of students receiving MBCI awards will be contacted prior to the ceremony. Parents/guardians are not notified individually for Honours and First Class Honours certificates. All parents/guardians are welcome to attend. The assembly is the last scheduled event for all middle school students for this school year.

Grade 5

Notes for all High School Families:

- June 12 is the end of regular classes for the school year for all high school students. Scheduled evaluations and the Awards Assembly are the only times students are asked to be at school following June 12.
- Please check the evaluation schedule carefully for the days that your child needs to be at school.
- High School Awards Assembly – The assembly begins at 9:00 am, lasts for about an hour, after which all students are dismissed. The assembly includes presentation of Honours and First Class Honours certificates as well as awards for Grades 9 - 11. All parents/guardians of students receiving MBCI awards will be contacted prior to the ceremony. Parents/guardians are not notified individually for Honours and First Class Honours certificates. All parents/guardians are welcome to attend. This is the last scheduled event of the school year for Grades 9 – 11.
