

MBCI Track and Field Day

Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

This memo comes to inform you of our annual Middle School Track and Field Day, which is approaching quickly. Please read the information carefully and make sure that you know exactly what is expected of our student athletes for that day.

When: Wednesday, May 20, 2026

Who: Grades 5-8

Location: River East Collegiate, 295 Sutton Ave.

Time: Attendance will be taken at 8:45 a.m. and 3:00 P.M

Transportation: Students are expected to get to River East Collegiate by 8:45 AM. **Please drop off students at the loop by the gym.** At that time, students will report to their crew teacher for attendance and further instructions provided. All students are expected to remain at River East Collegiate, help with the clean up and be present for the final attendance, which will be taken at 3:00 pm. **(Parents, students are not to be picked up prior to 3:00)**

BUS STUDENTS: Bus students will come to MBCI on their regular routes. When they arrive they will transfer onto one bus which will take them to River East. They will get picked up from River East at 3 by bus to head back to MBCI for their regular routes at the end of the day.

PARKING: PARKING IS PROHIBITED at River East Collegiate. Students pay for their spots. Please drop off quickly, or park at the River East arena on Rothesay if you are staying.

Lunch: Students are **not** allowed to leave the school grounds during the day. A hot dog vender will be on site and students are also encouraged to bring their own lunches and snacks. Washroom facilities will be available at the River East Collegiate.

What to bring: Check the forecast for the day and dress accordingly. Come prepared with sunscreen, a hat, plenty of liquids (a small cooler), and warm clothing if the forecast is calling for cool weather.

Cancellation policy: Mrs. Bartley will send out a Broadcast EDSBY message by 7:30 am if inclement weather forces us to postpone the meet. If the meet is postponed, classes would resume as usual at MBCI on May 20. The rain date for the track meet is Monday, May 25.

Our expectations: We want to see our school enjoy a great day of competition where we see student athletes giving it their best in the purest form of athletics. Students who

perform exceptionally well may be asked to represent MBCI at the RETSD Track and Field Day (Grades 6-8 only) on Thursday, May 28.

PHONES: Phones can be used for communication purposes with parents but are to remain in the student's backpack during the Track Meet.

Medical Exceptions and Injuries: If parents feel their child cannot take part for medical reasons, a note should be given to Mrs. A. Diboll, Mrs. N. Nachtigall, or Mrs. T. Toews in advance of May 20. Students who cannot compete will be asked to assist in other areas at the track meet.
